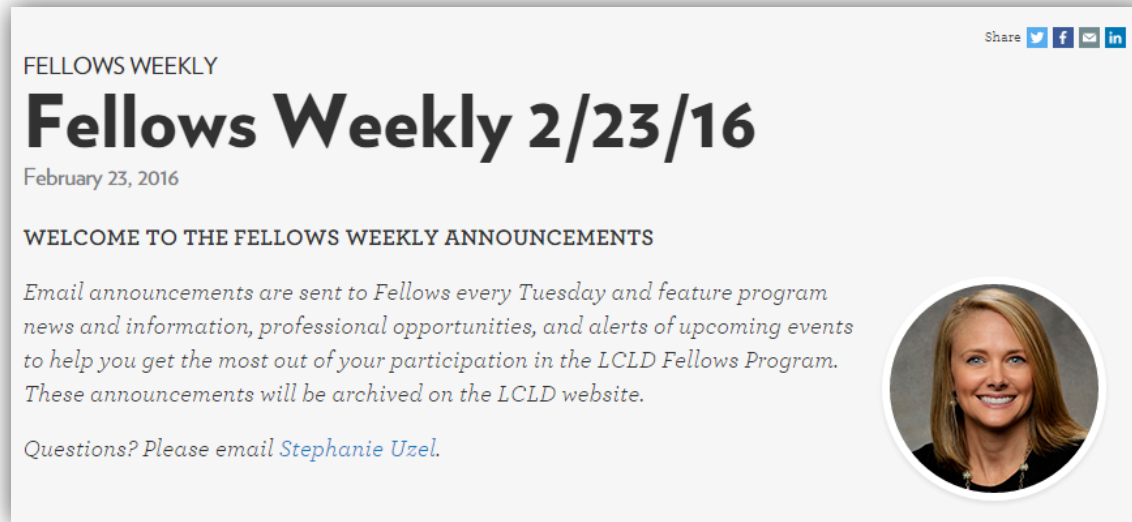

Christiane (Chrissy) Roussell

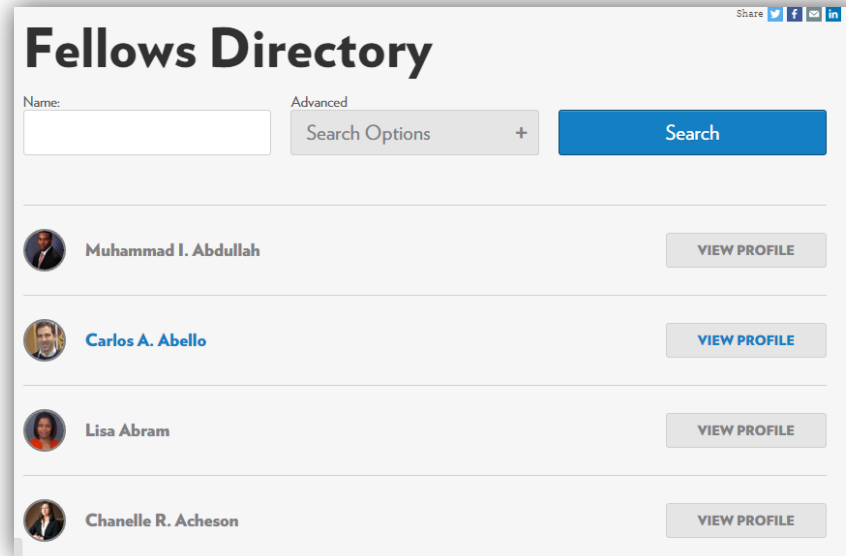
