Required qualifications are as follows –

- JD from an accredited U.S. law school or non-U.S. law degree with U.S. LLM in international trade discipline;
- DC bar or ability to waive into DC bar within first six months of employment;
- 4 to 5 years of experience in international trade compliance acquired in a law firm and/or in-house counsel position; and
- Strong working knowledge of the following laws and regulations: U.S. export controls (EAR/ITAR), U.S. economic sanctions, U.S. antiboycott, and U.S. customs.

In addition, the following qualifications are desirable but not required for consideration –

- Experience with CFIUS filings and proceedings;
- Knowledge of Lobbying Disclosure Act reporting requirements and related compliance processes;
- Knowledge of U.S. and non-U.S. supply chain security standards;
- Knowledge of non-U.S. export controls, economic sanctions, and customs regimes;
- Experience with the IT industry
- Spanish and/or Chinese language skills
- Limited domestic and international travel (approximately 3 to 6 trips per year)
