



The 2023 Tucker Ellis Summer Associate Mentorship Program for 1L LCLD Scholars provides a real-life, day-to-day sense of what it's like to practice law at Tucker Ellis and at a partnering corporation. The program pairs law students with experienced attorney mentors and introduces students to a range of litigation and transactional legal work. You will receive hands-on experience that may include opportunities such as attending court hearings and deal closings; observing depositions, witness interviews, and client meetings; performing research and due diligence; and drafting motions, deposition outlines, and contracts. Our program is designed to fit our culture of fostering strong relationships within both the firm and the Chicago community.
