

COVID Guidelines for 2022 Fellows “On-The-Road” Sessions

Protocols could change between now and the event. You will be alerted in advance of any additional check-in procedures. Please let [Nichole Velasquez](#) know if you have any questions.

Chicago:

No longer required to show proof of vaccination and no longer need to complete a screening form the day of visit. Below are procedures to enter the office:

- Upon arrival, you will have to show a photo ID, obtain a visitor’s pass, and proceed to the 44th floor
- If you are ill or have been experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, please postpone your visit to the office.

New York:

Visitors must show proof of vaccination and fill out a visitor health check at the lobby desk upon arrival.

San Francisco:

Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. “Fully vaccinated” means it has been two weeks since receiving either 1) both doses of either the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or 2) the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. You must certify that you do not currently have, and within the last 48 hours have not had, any of the following COVID-19 symptoms, which are new or not explained by another reason:

- fever or chills
- cough
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- muscle pain or body aches
- fatigue
- headache
- sore throat
- congestion or runny nose
- new loss of taste or smell
- diarrhea

Masks are not currently required for entry. Visitors are encouraged to make individual masking decisions based on their personal comfort level.

You must agree to notify Serge Verkhovsky, Director of Administration, (415)773-4233 if within 14 days after your visit to Orrick you have tested positive for COVID-19.
