Re: **LCLD Response to COVID-19 – Second Update**

In response to the rapidly evolving coronavirus COVID-19, the following is LCLD's plan regarding programs and events scheduled for June 2020:

LCLD 1L Scholars Summit

In response to the COVID-19 crisis and the stay-at-home orders in place in most states, LCLD has chosen to **cancel the *in-person* 1L Scholars Summit** scheduled for June 2-4, 2020, in Atlanta, GA. In place of the in-person meeting, we will instead offer enhanced virtual content for our 1L Scholars.

The virtual Scholars content will include:

- Best practices around how to succeed in virtual interviews, as well as multiple chances for Scholars to participate in virtual mock interviews with LCLD attorney volunteers
- A personalized, emotional intelligence assessment with lessons on how to utilize results to be successful in the workplace
- Interactive, virtual sessions on wellness, navigating generational differences, dispelling the myth of the billable hour, and lessons learned from seasoned attorneys
