Fellows are eligible to receive a stipend of US\$25,000 (less applicable taxes and withholdings) after acceptance of a full-time offer to join the Firm as an associate in 2023.

Eligibility:

Linklaters' Making Links 2L Diversity Fellowship is open to second-year law students from underrepresented groups in the legal profession.

To be an eligible applicant, a student must:

- > be enrolled in an ABA-accredited law school with an expected graduation date of 2023;
- > have a long-term interest in practicing law in one of Linklaters' U.S. offices; and
- > not be the recipient of a similar diversity award from another law firm or other employer during the same time period.

- 2. Unofficial undergraduate and law school transcripts
- 3. Legal writing sample of 10 pages or less
- 4. Personal statement of up to 500 words, addressing your:
 - > interest in working at a global firm;

 - > notable achievements and/or noteworthy leadership or other contributions to your community.
